Preparation:




- Wash the area to be painted with soap and water, then clean with DX330 ACRYLI-CLEAN® Wax and Grease Remover, SX1005 0.4 VOC Cleaner Wax and Grease Remover, DX394 1.4 Low VOC Cleaner or SX1004 Plastic Cleaner & Prep.
- Sand the bare metal areas completely with 80-180 grit abrasive.
- Re-clean with DX320, DX330, DX394 or SX1005. Final wipe with a clean damp cloth to remove any cleaner residue.
- DX103 may be used as a final wipe.
- Prime aluminum substrate as soon as possible and no later than 8 hours after cleaning steps.
- Prime carbon steel immediately after cleaning.
