To Whom It May Concern:

The following Flight has been authorized to operate and the provisions of FDC NOTAMS 1/0613, 1/0617, 1/0628 have been waived. The flights must comply with all other governing rules and regulations and security requirements.

Effective immediately and until further advised:

United States, Canadian, Mexican, Bahamian registered aircraft as well as aircraft registered in the Cayman Islands, British Virgin Island, and Bermuda, are authorized to operate to/from and within the airspace of the United States of America and it's territorial possessions. Operations to/from the above Islands and the Continental United States may be conducted using Instrument or Visual Flight Rules. Entry into the United States must be through a Port of Entry and all aircraft must be in compliance with FAA security regulations. Aircraft registered in the Countries/Islands identified in this waiver may operate the same as U.S. registered aircraft in accordance with FDC NOTAMS 1/0613, 1/0617, and 1/0628.
